Illness Policy:

TYWO follows the Huntsville City Schools (HCS) protocol. For respiratory illnesses such as Covid-19, flu, or RSV, individuals may return to school and normal activities if the following is true for at least 24 hours: symptoms have mostly resolved with overall improvement and if a fever was present, the fever has been gone without use of fever-reducing medication. HCS requires students to stay home for 24 hours after vomiting before returning to school. This policy is in place to help limit the spread of germs. Students should not return to school until 24 hours after their last episode of vomiting. Other symptoms that require students to stay home include fever, skin rash, diarrhea, and respiratory cough.

Behavior Policy:

Disrespect is not tolerated at any time within TYWO by parents or wrestlers. We, the coaches, are there to teach your child how to be the best version of themselves in a very mentally tough sport. We are all volunteers and want what is best for the children and the program. Children and parents will be spoken to with respect and we ask that everyone does the same. If a child is being disrespectful or outright a disruption we will take them off the mat and have them cool down for a couple minutes before we reengage and try to resolve the issue. It is at the coach's discretion whether or not to remove the wrestler from the wrestling room or team all together.
